New by ACCUSTIC ARTS[®]: UNCOMPRESSED WORLD VOL. II — double vinyl edition



It was in fact a small experiment when in 2009 the record label ACCUSTIC ARTS AUDIOPHILE RECORDING was founded. One year later, in 2010, with the release of "Uncompressed World Vol. II" it was clear that the experiment has succeeded. Another five years later we are now turning to a new chapter of the story. This is our first release on vinyl. As requested by many music lovers.

With this compilation we present a total of 15 different, excellent recordings with the focus on the female voice. The voices are all different and yet they have something in common: the tracks have a high musical and excellent sound quality. Along with a number of well–known names, there are also singers on this record who are mostly unknown to the listener. Let yourself be pleasantly surprised by the recordings, just as we were in the course of our extensive research and pre–listening activities.

Important mastering insights on Uncompressed World Vol. 2:

Similar to Vol. 1 the tasks set was to bring the variety of the selected songs which have been recorded in different time periods and with different recording formats to the final master with zero loss of quality. Pro Tools HD system was used to adjust the songs with the provided different formats and levels. Just like with Vol. 1 the POW-R #1 dithering algorithm was used to convert some tracks to 44.1 khz / 16 bits.

For the ideal no loss basis the premastering was done with Sonic Pre Master on DDP. In order to achieve optimum results at the vinyl mastering, we tried to preserve the most possible dynamic headroom. For the monitoring of Uncompressed World Vol. 2 we used ACCUSTIC ARTS AMP II –

MK 2, TUBE-PREAMP II as well as TUBE-DAC II on the electronics side as well as the PROLINE MK 3 speakers in a special crossover configuration in the nearfield. We thank you for opting for this double vinyl record and wish you many hours of analog musical enjoyment.
